The academic year commenced on June 1st with a palpable sense of enthusiasm and joy as both teachers and students eagerly entered the school compound. The year began with a prayer assembly and a prayer ceremony led by Rev. Fr. Mani Attel , vicar of st. Mary's Forane church and assistant vicar fr. Joseph Puthumana , setting a positive tone for the entire school community.

STUDENTS, FACULTY AND STAFF

In the current academic year the SMC family proudly encompasses 1642 students nurtured by a dedicated team of 66 well qualified teaching and non teaching staff. Complemented by the support of 16 supporting staff. Together we create a dynamic environment dedicated to educational excellence.

TOPPERS OF BOARD EXAMINATIONS IN AISSCE and AISSE

The echoes of success reverberated through our institution in March 2023 board examinations . A cohort of 86 class 10 students and 60 class 12 students displayed stellar performance, achieving a remarkable 100% pass rate. . In AISSE, 20 students scored 90+, 32 secured distinction, and 24 got first class , 6 of them secured full A +; and Milan V Sajith outshone with a remarkable 97.8%. In AISSCE, 10 scored 90+, 35 achieved distinction, and 15 scored first class. Niya Sabu claimed the pinnacle of achievement i with an impressive 96% and in commerce stream Adarsh P Nair became the topper with 93.3 % . These results underscore our commitment to academic excellence.
